EQUIPPING TOMORROW'S LEADERS TO
TRANSFORM SCOTLAND

The Scottish Public Leader training course seeks to equip emerging leaders who are passionate about bringing Christian leadership to all areas of life across Scotland. The course is part of the wider public leadership work of the Evangelical Alliance equipping and encouraging Christians to live out the God story in a way that changes culture – by intentionally, strategically taking a lead. There are annual cohorts in Scotland, England and Northern Ireland. We take participants on a nine-month journey of equipping, mentoring and support to grow into their unique role of leadership for the 21st century and be confident in their voice wherever God has called them. As well as learning from expert speakers in a range of fields, you will have the opportunity to build relationships with other emerging leaders from across the spheres of politics, the arts, media, academia, business, education, civil society, and more.

WHAT?

- 3 weekend equipping events
- Regular mentoring from a public leader throughout
- Evening discovery visits and events at key locations
- Time with key Scottish public leaders
- Individual reflection, projects and growth

WHEN?

The first weekend will be in Autumn 2018. There will be one SPL event or mentoring session each month until June 2019.

WHO?

- Up to 20 emerging leaders working in key areas of Scottish public life
- 25-35 age range
- Passion for Christ
- Sense of call to leadership
- Evidence of activating that calling
- Recognised by their church
- Humble and teachable character

WHAT WILL THE CURRICULUM INVOLVE?

We draw together a bespoke curriculum for the course based on good practice from Scotland and beyond. Content includes Christian character and leadership, cultural intelligence, calling, communication and competency.

WHAT ABOUT THE MENTORING?

All participants will be paired with an experienced mentor. These are experienced leaders who will walk the journey with you over the 9 months ensuring that you are able to put into practice what God is teaching you throughout the year.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Most of the costs are covered by the programme but we ask for a contribution from participants of around £600. Bursaries may be available in cases of financial need.
